

Course Description

Students will immerse themselves in the beauty of the Spanish language and the richness of its diverse cultures. In the Spanish 1 course, students will learn basic grammar and vocabulary skills to help build their fluency and language proficiency. They will explore the culture of Spanish-speaking countries through engaging interactive games, videos, and audio recordings and apply what they learn through written practice, listening, and speaking exercises.

This is a yearlong course consisting of 7 units. Upon successful completion students will receive 1 credit towards high school graduation.
