Creative Writing Syllabus

Course Description

For many hundreds of years, literature has been one of the most important human art forms. It allows us to give voice to our emotions, create imaginary worlds, express ideas, and escape the confines of material reality. Through creative writing, we can come to better understand ourselves and our world. This course will provide students with a solid grounding in the writing process, from finding inspiration to building a basic story. Then, students will learn more complicated literary techniques to create strange hybrid forms of poetry and prose. By the end of this course, students will be able to better discover their creative thoughts and turn those ideas into fully realized pieces of creative writing.

This is a 1 semester course consisting of 8 units. Upon successful completion students will receive 0.5 credit towards high school graduation.
